Former Seattle Supersonics Head Coach, Tom Newell



Tom Newell has accomplished just about all there is as a basketball coach. In addition to being the Head Coach of the Seattle Supersonics in the late 1980's, Newell was also an assistant coach with the Dallas Mavericks and the New Jersey Nets. He has been an NBA scout for the Milwaukee Bucks and served as the Director of Player Personnel for the Indiana Pacers in 1984. He began his international resume in 1985 as the Head Coach in the top professional league in Greece, and continued as the Mens National Team Coach of Japan in 2000. Since leaving the

NBA, his coaching clinics and players camps have spanned the globe: Russia, Ireland, Belgium, Korea, Venezuela, Guatemala, Spain, China and the Phillipines. Newell currently represents the State Department as a Sports Ambassador, teaching coaches and players about the game of basketball. He also represents FIBA as one of their Expert Instructors in their Olympic Development Program.

And he will be coming to Calgary in May!!!
